HOME BRED DAIRY YOUNGSTOCK COMPETITION

Judge— Ms T Summerfield

Entries close: 5th June 2019

Judging between: 19th and 30th June 2019

Class 16—For the best large youngstock herd

Trophy—The Bagshaws Challenge Cup is presented to the best large herd

Class 17—For the best small youngstock herd

Trophy—The Bagshaws Challenge Cup is presented to the best small herd

Note—All female youngstock must be shown and should include reared calves, yearlings and in calf heifers.

HARVEST BASKET

A competition open to members in two classes, to be judged on ploughing and hedge cutting match day (Saturday 14th September 2019).

All entries to be presented in a suitable basket.

All entries must be in place by 10.30am on match day.

Any exhibitor may retrieve their entry between 4pm and 5pm on match day.

After 5pm exhibits will be disposed of at the Chairman's discretion.

Class 1 - Basket of produce consisting of home grown fruit, vegetables, fungi or flowers.

Class 2 - Basket containing produce, as class 1, from any other source.

Classes will be judged to three places, with place cards awarded

SPECIMEN GRAIN AND PRODUCE COMPETITION

A competition open to members to be judged on ploughing and hedge cutting match day (Saturday 14th September 2019)

All entries will have been harvested during the current harvest year.

All entries must be grown by exhibitor.

All entries must be in place by 11am on match day.

Any exhibitor may retrieve their entry between 4pm and 5pm on match day.

After 5pm exhibits will be disposed of at the Chairman's discretion.

SPECIMEN GRAIN

Class 1. Wheat. A 1.5kg sample of wheat in a clear plastic bag, maximum 15% moisture and of a named variety. If entry numbers allow the class will be split into milling and feed sections, at the Stewards discretion.

Class 2. Barley. A 1.5kg sample of barley in a clear plastic bag, maximum 15% moisture and of a named variety. If entry numbers allow the class will be split into malting and feed sections, at the Stewards discretion.

Class 3. Oats. A 1.5kg sample of oats in a clear plastic bag, maximum 15% moisture and of a named variety.

Class 4. Oil seed rape. A 1.5kg sample of oil seed rape in a clear plastic bag, maximum 8% moisture and of a named variety.

Class 5. Beans. A 1.5kg sample of beans in a clear plastic bag, maximum 15% moisture and of a named variety.

SPECIMEN PRODUCE

Class 6. Hay. A small conventional bale of hay or approximately 5 kg sample taken from a big bale and presented in a suitable plastic bag.

Class 7. Maize. Two stems of growing maize, cut at ground level, presented in a bundle.

All classes will be judged to three places, with place cards awarded.

Judging between: 19th & 30th June 2019

Class 18—For the best herd of dairy cattle any breed pedigree/non pedigree herds

Note—all the necessary records should be made available at the time of judging
